

LOUDON Town Beach



The Loudon Town Beach offers a roped, sunny swimming spot, with a shallow area and a deeper pool.

On a tree-lined shore, some may be interested in tadpole and frog hunting, or observing small crabs, crawfish, and other fish.

There is a sparse amount of sand for relaxing on shore, a picnic table, and trees for shade.

DIRECTIONS

Take a left out onto Route 106 North

Go about 3.3 miles

Take a left onto Clough Pond Road

Go about 1 mile. You'll see the boat ramp first, on the left at the corner of Berry Road

The beach parking area is just ahead on the right
