To obtain a burn permit, you must fill out this application first, with the appropriate Board member signature, and bring it to the Loudon Fire Department. They will inspect your site and issue a permit if you are in compliance with all State & Town laws, and Community rules. **Please return a copy of your permit to Freedom Hill Cooperative by dropping it in the FHC Office Box.** See the box below for guidelines.

Guidelines for an outdoor burn in the Cooperative:

- No permanent fireplaces are permitted in the park (brick, stone, any built-in structure)
- All fire devices must be portable (chiminea, fire pit table, fire cage)
- Category I burns must have a 25-ft clearance from structures. Category II and Category III burns must have a 50-ft clearance from structures
- All burns must be Category I if your lot does not have a 50-ft clearance from structures, including your home, shed, deck, or a neighbor's property
- Permits from the Loudon Fire Department are not required when there is sufficient snow coverage on the ground, but FHC will still require this form to be on file for any burns within the park
- All seasonal permits issued must be renewed from year to year, and a copy must be submitted to FHC

Category I: campfire, 2x2 burn area, any time
 Category II: 4x4 burn area, after 5pm*
 Category III: brush fire, large bonfire, after 5pm*

* unless actively raining
